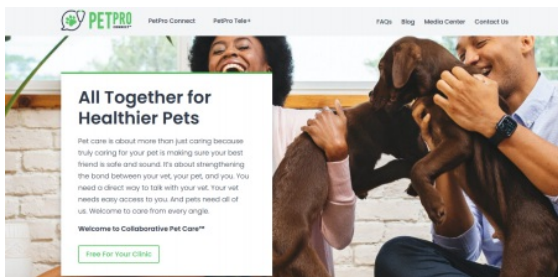

Before I left Alquilando, we were starting the backend refactoring from CodeIgniter to Laravel (A more structured PHP framework) to accomplish the same success we had on the front end.
